This is a picture of Buddle with its current main. The head of the sail is well below the black band and the luff measures 11.3 meters. The roach is well clear of the backstay and the boom clears the spray hood. Please note that the measurement of the main are not the same as that given on the internet. I understand that a shorter mast was fitted to some boats. The foot measurement is 3.9 meters. The sail battens are 107mm, 200mm, 278mm and 335mm. The two short battens are 8mm diameter and the long ones are 10mm. Batten ends are 20mm wide for the 8mm battens and 32mm wide for the 10mm battens.



The sail was off the boat but I measured on the boat without the sail and checked once I had got the sail back from the sailmaker. I found the cut back A to be 92mm and the cut up B 7mm.

The sail does have a cunningham.







Pictured top is the clew slug to the clew of the loose footed sail.

Pictured below is the clew outhaul with shackle. The main halyard is attached to the shackle.





Mast bend was estimated to be 120mm on the mast and confirmed on the sail.
